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Training for Mentors in Slovenia

Training for mentors of the DigiFUnCollab project was conducted from September 2 to 4 in Piran and Celje, Slovenia; some participants joined online. The activity was attended by 25 participants from Germany, Italy, Romania, and Slovenia. The program was designed to prepare participants to mentor students in establishing social entrepreneurship projects for university-community engagement. Throughout the workshop, materials from the Digital Self-learning Course on Social Entrepreneurship, consisting of 10 modules (9 for students and 1 for mentors), along with good practices in social entrepreneurship, were thoroughly presented and discussed.
